

How to Register

1. Register your project through the official BMIE Challenge Registration Portal: <http://bmie-challenge.com>.
 2. A confirmation email will be sent to the registered email address upon successful registration.
 3. Each project team may consist of up to **five members**, including the team leader.
 4. Upload your project video to your **personal YouTube account**. Ensure the video privacy setting is set to **Public** or **Unlisted**.
 5. Submit your **YouTube video link** and any supporting documents (optional) via the BMIE Challenge Portal.
 6. Complete the **participation fee payment** through the same portal.
 7. The organizing team will verify your payment, video submission, and any supporting documents provided.
 8. Once verified, your video link will be displayed on the official challenge website.
 9. All submitted projects will be reviewed by a panel of expert judges.
 10. Results will be announced on the website and sent via email to participants.
 11. **The judges' decisions are final. Appeals will not be considered.**

Video Submission Guidelines

General Requirements

- **Duration:** Maximum 5 minutes
- **Orientation:** Landscape format
- **Submission:** Upload the video to your personal YouTube channel. Set visibility to **Unlisted** or **Public**

Video Content Requirements

1. Start with an introduction of all team members, including their names and affiliated organization or university.
2. The video should clearly cover the following elements:
 - Project Introduction
 - Motivation behind the project
 - Innovation highlights
 - Contribution to Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
 - Commercialization potential

- Related publications (if available)
- Copyright status (if applicable)
- Any additional relevant information
